Study Abroad in Europe

IELTS

IELTS, the International English Language Testing System, is designed to assess the language ability of non-native speakers of English who need to study or work where English is the language of communication. IELTS assesses all of your English skills — reading, writing, listening and speaking, and is designed to reflect how you will use English at study, at work, and at play, in your new life abroad. There are two Modules; Academic and General Training. There are four sub-tests, or modules, to the IELTS test: Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking with a band score of 0 to 9 for each module.



Reading

The reading component consists of two parts, one is Academic and other is General Training, as mostly students opt for Academic the pattern is expounded below but in IELTS the candidate has to go under easier reading session which are generally of lower standard. The test lasts 60 minutes with 40 questions between them. Each question carries one mark. Scores out of 40 are converted to the IELTS 9-band scale.



Writing

The writing component consists of two parts, one is Academic and other one is General, as mostly students opt for Academic Pattern which is bit tough in General IELTS the candidate has to undergo letter writing session. Task Two carries more weight in your final band score than Task One. Remember that illegible handwriting will reduce your final score. Writing test consists of two tasks and lasts for 60 minutes.



Speaking

The IELTS speaking test takes around 11 to 14 minutes and is in the form of an interview. The Interview will most probably seem like a friendly conversation, which typically will cover some aspect of your past, present and the future situation. It is designed to assess how well a candidate communicates or ally in English throughout the test.



Listening

The Listening test is 30 minutes long and is four recorded monologues and conversations. The listening material is recorded on a cassette tape/CD/DVD/which you will hear only once. There are 40 questions altogether. Each question carries one mark. At the end of the recorded material you will be given ten minutes to copy your answers in to the answer sheet.
