



Required Documents for F1 Visa Interview

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F-1 Visa Interview Document Checklist

Preparing for your U.S. F-1 visa interview? Use this checklist to make sure you have the essential documents ready before your appointment.

Required Documents

1. Valid Passport

Make sure your passport is valid for your intended period of travel.

2. English Language Test Report

IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, Duolingo, or another accepted English proficiency test, if applicable.

3. Signed Form I-20

Carry the original Form I-20 issued by your university and make sure you have signed it.

4. Academic Documents

Bring your relevant academic transcripts, certificates, mark sheets, and graduation documents.

5. DS-160 Confirmation Page

Print and carry the confirmation page containing your barcode.

6. Two Visa Photographs

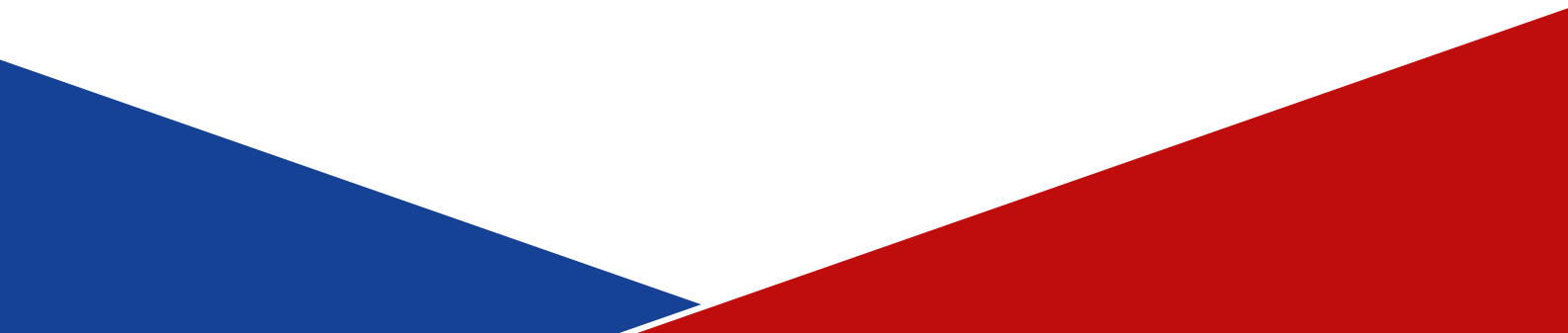
2 × 2 inch photographs taken within the last six months and meeting U.S. visa photo requirements.

7. SEVIS I-901 Fee Payment Confirmation

Carry proof that you have paid your SEVIS fee.

8. Visa Interview Appointment Confirmation

Print your U.S. visa interview appointment confirmation page.



Additional Documents Recommended

It is also a good idea to carry:

- University admission or offer letter
- Financial documents or bank statements
- Sponsorship documents, if applicable
- Scholarship or assistantship letter, if applicable
- Proof of relationship with your sponsor
- Supporting documents explaining your study plans and funding

Important Reminder

The U.S. Embassy or Consulate may request additional documents depending on your individual application. Always check the latest official requirements before attending your visa interview.

Tip: Keep your documents organized in a folder in the order you may need to present them during your interview.



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
